Democracy and local control

The proposed merger of the Huronia District Hospital (HDH) with the Penetanguishene General Hospital (PGH) under the sponsorship of the Catholic Health Corporation of Ontario has taken everybody by surprise. There was no public discussion or debate about the merger until some HDH board members resigned in protest. This is not acceptable. Our hospital should remain public and accountable to the whole community.

Loss of full range of health services

Our community stands to lose the full range of health services, including reproductive health services such as abortion, tubal ligation and vasectomies. Other concerns arise out of this ill-conceived proposal, including end-of-life issues and health services for our gay and lesbian community members.

Our community fought for a full range of health services and we can win this fight too!
