Our hospitals are facing a \$5 million cut. This, after years of devastating cuts to staff and services as a result of inadequate funding by the Ontario government. In 2014, Petrolia's endoscopy unit was closed – one of the few remaining services, leaving the hospital's future at risk. Just last year, 66,000 hours/year of hands-on nursing care were cut at the Sarnia site due to a \$6 million funding shortfall.
