Ontario Health Coalition COVID-19 Outbreaks in Non-Healthcare Settings Updated to: October 28 2020 Released on November 3, 2020

Introduction

COVID-19 cases in Ontario's general population hit an all-time high in this period both in single day total positive cases and in the rolling averages, increasing 24% in two weeks from October 13, 2020¹, to October 28, 2020². Yet clear data on how the virus is being transmitted amongst the general population is still not available. Peel, with the highest rate of case positivity (6.5 percent of people tested are testing positive) did not contact trace 16.9 percent of the cases in the last week of October. In other areas considered "hot spots" the state of contact tracing ranges widely. In the last week of October, the percentage of COVID-positive cases that have not been contact traced are: Toronto 65 percent; Durham 27.5 percent; Ottawa 48.8 percent; Peel 16.9 percent.³ During the two week period ending October 28, and limited by the poor contact tracing, Public Health Ontario tracked an increase of 14.49% in non-health care workplace outbreak cases.⁴⁵ This report looks more deeply at the spread of COVID-19 in those workplace settings that are not health care settings. (We are releasing a separate report on outbreaks in health care settings.)

Clear information to the public about where they are most at risk is still not being provided, but the available data, incomplete as it is, gives some insight into the trends. Even with insufficient reporting in almost all public health units we were able to find that several industries are far surpassing the increase in cases in the general public. Cases in school have grown the most significantly, increasing 67.76% in two weeks while general community spread increased 24% in those same two weeks. Retail outbreaks have continued to grow at a rate of 27.97% in this reporting period and outbreaks public services have also grown at a rate of 26.34% in this report. Developmental services have also seen a significant increase, increasing 21.26% in two weeks.

While the Ontario government is reporting all cases in schools on their website, they are only classifying 233 cases⁶ out of 2,001 cases in schools⁷ as being a part of an outbreak. The government

has adopted a different definition of "outbreak" in schools, requiring a known epi-link,⁸ which means proven, direct contact or exposure between cases. But students and teachers share washrooms, playgrounds, gyms, locker spaces and lunch rooms. The bottom line is that growth in the numbers of cases in schools is far higher than in the general public. There is no explanation for this in the Public Health data that has been released. Currently, they are declaring that only 11.6% of cases in schools are the result of an outbreak. Outbreak protocols in schools include the isolation of potentially exposed students or a partial or full school dismissal. As the second wave is progressing we are seeing more and more schools remaining open with multiple cases in both students and staff. There is no way to verify the quality and thoroughness of contact tracing that is being done in schools but the growth in school COVID-positive case numbers which are so much higher than the general population raise questions about what is happening.

The report below includes the data that is available on outbreaks in workplaces that are not health care settings. In a separate report, also released today, we dig more deeply into outbreaks in health care settings. In the latter report, we can see that the general population spread is now seriously impacting long-term care, retirement homes and hospitals. Yet while a full opening is being planned, even with the highest case numbers per day that our province has yet seen and with case numbers and deaths increasing among the most vulnerable populations, there remains no plan to disclose information that would enable people in an "open market" to be able to make informed choices to reduce their most risky behaviour and contacts. There appears to be no plan to improve public information and data about where transmission is occurring, to provide resources for contact tracing in Toronto and other hot spots, or to require the release of information about outbreaks in workplaces. This raises serious questions: what is the goal of Ontario's COVID response? What are the plans for the sectors that are seeing increases far above the general population's? If the market is going to be allowed to rule, and we are not condoning this approach, then why cannot people be given full information to make safer choices?

Even with our best efforts at tracking, we were only able to find a small portion of cases in workplace outbreaks by name of the facility, because only Hamilton Public Health is reporting all local workplace outbreaks. Ottawa and York are reporting congregate care (Developmental Homes and Social Services), Windsor-Essex and Chatham Kent are reporting agriculture cases and Toronto is not reporting any workplace outbreaks at all outside of schools, long-term care, retirement homes and homeless shelters.

This total includes cases that we had previously tracked plus all of the cases that the province is reporting since September. We have also included outbreaks in faith schools, administrative offices, student residences and private schools in our total.

Agriculture

Deaths of Three Migrant Workers:

1. On May 30, Bonifacio Eugenio-Romero, a 31-year old migrant worker from central Mexico, became the first foreign agricultural worker to die in Ontario from COVID-19. Eugenio-Romero had been in the country since early April and worked for Woodside Greenhouses Inc. in Kingsville, Ontario.

2. On June 5, a second worker, 24-year-old Rogelio Muñoz Santos, who also worked on a farm in Windsor-Essex died from COVID-19.

3. Fifty-five-year-old Juan Chaparro had been coming to Canada to work since 2010 and was employed at Norfolk County's Scotlynn Group farm, where there has been a cluster outbreak of COVID-19. He is the third migrant worker to die this month after contracting COVID-19. The two others died in the Windsor area.¹⁰

London/St Thomas:

London-Ontario Plants Propagation facility: May 29 2020

Eight migrant workers at the Ontario Plants Propagation facility outside of St. Thomas have tested positive for COVID-19. The workers live in London but travel to the operation at 38024 John Wise Line.¹¹

London-Ontario Plants Propagation facility: July 8 2020

Twenty migrant workers at the Ontario Plants Propagation facility outside of St. Thomas have tested positive for COVID-19. Two agriculture workers have also tested positive for COVID-19. The workers live in London but travel to the operation at 38024 John Wise Line.¹²

Haldimand Norfolk:

Haldimand Norfolk-Scotlynn Group: June 25 2020

Approximately 220 migrant farm workers live in residences on the farm. Approximately 200 people have tested positive. Two workers are currently hospitalized.¹³

Windsor Essex and Niagara:

June 9 2020

It is estimated that there have been 400 agriculture and food workers who have tested positive in the Windsor, Essex, and Niagara region. There have also been two Mexican migrant workers who have passed away from COVID-19 and 2 more who are currently in Intensive Care. The Windsor Essex Public Health Unit reported 43 new cases on June 9th 2020, which was the highest spike since the disease peaked in mid-April. There have also been 34 more COVID-19 cases in the town of Learnington which hosts over 8,000 migrant workers, who live in communal housing and work together closely without proper access to PPE. There have been 17 farms with COVID-19 outbreaks, but the Public Health Units are not releasing their names. The worst outbreaks have been at Greenhill Produce in Kentbridge, Scotlynn Group in Norfolk County and Ontario Plants Propagation of St Thomas.¹⁴

Niagara:

Pioneer Flower Farms: June 4 2020

St. Catharines greenhouse, Pioneer Flower Farms, has become the site of the single largest jump in local COVID-19 cases since the pandemic hit Niagara in March. 60 workers have been placed in isolation of which 40 have tested positive.¹⁵

Pioneer Flower Farms: July 10 2020

Pioneer Flower Farms had at least 65 workers test positive for COVID-19, increasing by 5 since the early reports of the outbreak in June. $^{\rm 16}$

Windsor Essex

June 29 2020

The health unit says a total of 674 agri-farm workers have tested positive for the virus in the region. Six workplaces in the agriculture sector are in outbreak status – four in Leamington

and two In Kingsville. ¹⁷ Naturefresh in Learnington has had 191 cases of COVID-19 in their agriculture migrant workforce over this weekend. ¹⁸

July 14 2020

The health unit says a total of 824 agri-farm workers have tested positive for the virus in the region (an increase of 150 since June 29). 19

Leamington & Kingsville Agricultural Facilities: July 7 2020

The COVID-19 outbreaks at two agricultural facilities in Leamington and two agricultural facilities in Kingsville continue.²⁰

August 25 2020

The health unit says a total of 1170 agri-farm workers have tested positive for the virus in the region (an increase of 346 since July 14). There are currently two active outbreaks in agriculture facilities in Learnington ²¹

September 17 2020

The health unit says a total of 1176 agri-farm workers have tested positive for the virus in the region (an increase of 6 since August 25). There no outbreaks reported in Windsor Essex ²²

October 15 2020

The health unit says a total of 1200 agri-farm workers have tested positive for the virus in the region (an increase of 24 since September 17). There is one farm with an active outbreak in the region with 17 reported cases involved in the outbreak. ^{23 24}

Chatham Kent

Greenhill Produce: June 15 2020

An outbreak was investigated at the end of April with 40 agricultural workers testing positive for COVID-19 at Greenhill Produce. $^{\rm 25}$

Greenhill Produce: July 2 2020

The outbreak at Greenhill Produce has grown to 103 cases in their workers but has now been resolved. $^{\rm 26}$

Chatham-Kent Agricultural Industry: August 25 2020

The Chatham-Kent Public Health Unit has reported 108 Temporary Foreign Workers and 130 Farm Workers have tested positive for COVID-19 $\,^{27}$

Chatham-Kent Agricultural Industry: September 17 2020

The Chatham-Kent Public Health Unit has reported 112 Temporary Foreign Workers and 129 Farm Workers have tested positive for COVID-19 $^{\ 28}$

Chatham-Kent Agricultural Industry: October 15 2020

The Chatham-Kent Public Health Unit has reported 111 Temporary Foreign Workers and 133 Farm Workers have tested positive for COVID-19 $^{\ 29}$

Simcoe-Muskoka:

Two Unidentified Farms: June 17 2020

Two outbreaks have been declared in Simcoe County with one farm having 9 cases in their workers and the other farm having 3 workers test positive for COVID-19. 30

Vaughan:

Ravine Mushroom Farm: July 6 2020

There have been 30 confirmed cases of COVID-19 among agricultural workers at the Ravine Mushroom Farm in Vaughan. $^{\rm 31}$

Food Processing

Brampton:

Maple Lodge Farms: May 7 2020

Maple Lodge Farms in Brampton have had 25 workers test positive for COVID-19 and one worker has passed away from the virus. Maple Lodge Farms is being criticized for failing to report their first positive case for over three weeks. ³² As of June 8 2020 ,Maple Lodge Farms has reported that they have not had a new case of COVID-19 in their facilities for three weeks. ³³

Kitchener:

Conestoga Meat: May 22 2020

Conestoga Meat in Kitchener had to close production for a time in order to contain their COVID-19 outbreak. To date they have had 91 workers at their Breslau plant test positive for COVID-19, however 71 of those cases are now resolved.³⁴

York Region:

Saputo Dairy Products: May 19 2020

As of May 19 2020, there had been 50 cases of COVID-19 from workplace exposures in York Region. The largest being an outbreak at Saputo Dairy Products where 24 workers tested positive for COVID-19 and one worker passed away from the virus. The other locations have not been disclosed by the public health unit. There have been 31 workers test positive in Vaughan with one worker ending up in the ICU, 9 workers test positive in Markham with two workers hospitalized and one in the ICU, 3 workers test positive in Newmarket with one death and two currently self-isolating, 3 workers test positive in Richmond Hill with one ending up in the ICU, 2 testing positive in Aurora and 2 in Whitchurch-Stouffville.³⁵

Waterloo:

Food Processing Plant: June 2 2020

An outbreak is ongoing at a food processing plant in Waterloo with 14 workers testing positive for COVID-19. Waterloo Public Health has not released any more information about the facility. 36

Food Processing Plant: July 14 2020

Two undisclosed outbreaks in Waterloo have been declared resolved with a total of 112 cases. $^{\rm 37}$

Burford- Ferrero Plant: July 14 2020

One staff member at the Ferrero Plant has tested positive for COVID-19. ³⁸

Toronto:

FGF Bakery: June 24 2020

Two outbreaks occurred in FGF Bakery in Toronto resulting in 184 employees testing positive for COVID-19 and one staff member dying from the virus, the outbreaks have now been declared resolved and details have only recently been released to the public.³⁹

Social Services

Toronto:

Willowdale Welcome Centre: May 24 2020

Willowdale Welcome Centre is a Refugee Support Centre in Toronto which housed roughly 200 refugees seeking a better life in Canada. To date over 24 workers at Willowdale Welcome Centre have tested positive for COVID-19 and 180 clients at the welcome centre have also tested positive.⁴⁰

Ottawa:

Association Pour L'Integration Sociale D'Ottawa: May 4 2020

Ottawa Public Health reported that Association Pour L'Integration Sociale D'Ottawa, a nonprofit institution, declared an outbreak on April 24 and has 1 case in a staff member. The outbreak has now been resolved⁴¹

Association Pour L'Integration Sociale D'Ottawa: October 15 2020

Ottawa Public Health has report that the non-profit group has had outbreaks in 6 different locations starting in September with a total of 31 cases (10 residents and 21 staff members have tested positive for the virus)⁴²

Association Pour L'Integration Sociale D'Ottawa: October 28 2020

Ottawa Public Health has report that the non-profit group has had outbreaks in 6 different locations starting in September with a total of 35 cases (an increase of four)⁴³

Innovative Community Services: October 15 2020

An outbreak was declared Innovative Community Services with one staff member testing positive for COVID-19.⁴⁴

Innovative Community Services: October 28 2020
