

## Ontario has the lowest revenues per person of any province in Canada

Ontario Revenues Collected Per Capita to Fund Our Social Programs

Most Recent Data (2017)



- Ontario collects \$10,415 per capita or per person to fund all our social programs including health care and education.
- The average of the rest of the country is \$12,373 per capita.
- If Ontario was to boost revenues to match the average of the other provinces, we would have \$1,958 more per person x 14 million population (2017)
   = \$27.4 billion more in total to fund our social programs.
